With a man-made lagoon, a popular wave pool and a saltwater beach, there is something for everyone. If you are seeking peace and quiet, find a spot on the shady lawn or wander the pretty parklands. If you'd prefer to step up the action, try flyboarding, or scale one of the floating jumping castles. The Waterfront Precinct also has a great range of <u>restaurants and cafes</u>, to satisfy any connoisseur. Come night-time, treat yourself to an alfresco movie at <u>Deckchair Cinema</u>. It screens films seven nights a week during the dry season and is right on the water. With a free 12-seater shuttle bus operating daily, the Darwin Waterfront precinct should be a must for all visitors.
