Discover the enchanting oasis of George Brown Botanic Gardens, just moments from the city center. Meander through lush monsoon forests, coastal fore-dunes, and mangroves, immersing yourself in the diverse tapestry of flora from northern Australia and tropical regions worldwide. Marvel at vibrant heliconias, gingers, orchids, and bromeliads in a riot of colors amidst the exotic plantings. Explore the African-Madagascan garden, home to majestic baobab and boab trees, while little ones find delight in the playground and treehouse nestled within the verdant surroundings. Experience the soothing cascade of the rainforest waterfall or encounter ancient cycads in the captivating cycad garden. Relax on expansive lawns, enchanted by Darwin's largest ornamental fountain, or embark on self-guided tree walks. Join guided tours to uncover hidden gems and encounter Rufous Owls amidst the foliage, or simply unwind with coffee and cake at Eva's Café.

Stumble upon Darwin's vibrant street art while exploring the city's laneways. Since 2017, the Darwin Street Art Festival has transformed walls into a captivating gallery, showcasing works by international, national, and local artists.

To fully immerse yourself, download the Darwin Street Art Festival app before embarking on your stroll. Gain insight into the artists and their creations, and experience some murals come to life through augmented reality.
